Adapting an existing 4:3 PowerPoint Presentation to 16:9

- Step 1: Open an existing PowerPoint presentation on your PC or Mac.
- Step 2: From the top menu, select **Design**, then **Page Setup**.
- Step 3: Change "Slides sized for" dropdown to: On screen Show (16:9).
- Note: Other settings in this box should be: Slides: Landscape, Notes, handouts & outline: Portrait. Click OK.
- Step 4: Locate your first image in the slide deck and right click it. (Control-click on Mac).
- Step 5: From the drop-down list, select Format Picture, and then select Size.
- Step 6: In the Scale area of the box that opens, ensure that the Lock aspect ratio box is checked, and then just click the

 Height increase (up) arrow once and then decrease (down) once. Changing the scale by one step and then

 switching it back will correct the aspect ratio of your image to fit your new presentation ratio.
- Step 7: Repeat steps 5 and 6 to the end of your slide deck.
- Step 8: Save your presentation.
