The workshop will be offered on June 21 and with a second offering on July 12.

The workshop is designed to provide practical, straightforward information on topics of importance to anyone that owns or operates a dam. The purpose of this one-day workshop is to educate dam owners and operators about the following topics:

- State dam safety laws and regulations
- Extreme storm events and potential dam failure conditions
- Owner responsibilities, liabilities, and security issues
- Dam operations, maintenance, and inspections
- Developing and implementing emergency action plans
- Procedures for retaining a professional engineer to inspect, investigate, and evaluate dams.
